## DASH DISASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS


- Carefully unclip the dash trim bezel from around the radio (see photo below), disconnect the climate control harness and remove trim bezel.
- Remove the (4) Phillips screws securing the radio/hazard button assembly to the sub-dash.
- Pull radio forward, disconnect the wire harness(s) and antenna lead and remove radio/hazard button assembly.
- 4. There is no need to unplug and remove the hazard button assembly, just set aside carefully.



## SINGLE ISO w/POCKET INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Insert ISO brackets to rear of kit as shown in Figure A
- Insert pocket into lower section of kit from rear & lock into slots of mounting brackets.
- Insert ISO mountable radio between ISO mount brackets and loosely attach to sides
  of radio using screws provided with radio when possible or screws supplied with kit.
- 4. Slide radio forward or backward for desired look and tighten screws.
- 5. Attach a rear support bracket to the rear of the new radio and adjust as necessary to support the weight of the radio (Optional)





## DOUBLE DIN INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Attach ISO brackets to the rear of the main mounting kit.
- 2. Slide radio into kit from rear & attach to ISO mounting brackets using screws supplied with radio when possible or screws supplied with kit (do not tighten screws at this time).
- 3. Slide radio forward or backward for your desired look and then tighten the mounting screws.

4. Suggested...Attach rear support.
